You will need: a house plant, a place to keep it in, and some water to feed it.

- Take care of those worst affected
 - The poor, the homeless, people of color, those living in the global south

But still we must cherish it. When you remove the plug in the bottom of the pot, tell the plant a story of the following:

- A place in this land that brings you joy
- A place in this land that you want to meet for the first time
- A place in this land that you want to see again
- A place in this land that you think of as family
